












Hazardous Waste Incineration

- Organic-based wastes from various industrial/manufacturing processes
- Reactive materials
- DEA-controlled substances
- Consumer commodities
- Household-hazardous wastes
- Mixed infectious and hazardous waste
- Ozone-depleting substances (gases)
- Lab packs
- Pharmaceuticals
- Bulk soils, solids, and liquids





Inorganic Waste Treatment

- Aqueous treatment of heavy metal bearing wastewaters
- Encapsulation of heavy metal contaminated debris
- Stabilization of heavy metals in soils, filtercakes, and sludges
- Cyanide destruction
- Neutralization of strong acid and caustic wastes
- Patented mercury recycling program and reuse of sugar-based liquids



Hazardous Waste Landfill

- LDR compliant waste
- Sediments from dredging
- Waste treatment residues
- Remediation soils
- CAMU eligible wastes
- PCB remediation wastes
- Demolition debris
- Asbestos





Fuel Blending

Waste-derived fuel is produced by blending of organic materials such as:

- Solids, liquids, sludges, and aerosols
- Many other wastes with energy value including debris and consumer products

This process creates an alternative fuel source that:

- Replaces coal and natural gas in cement kilns
- Supports electricity production at waste-to-energy facilities
